Sermon Series: Called by God

The Book of Jeremiah is a collection of prophetic poems and stories by Jeremiah and his scribe, Baruch. Prophetic literature contains many word pictures that vividly illustrate God's love for His creation, as well as humankind's rebellion against our Creator. The poetic nature of the message aims to not only present information, but to evoke emotion in the hearers so that we would be moved to respond with repentance and worship.

In this sermon series, we will prayerfully study several poems and stories from Jeremiah. Our hope is that as we grasp God's love for us and His call on our lives, we will respond to His Word with loving worship and obedience.

This Week: Called by God

The Bible is clear that we are fearfully and wonderfully crafted for God's marvellous purpose of building His Kingdom for His glory and the salvation of humankind. He calls for us to leave behind our old patterns of self-centeredness and to work as a part of His team so that we can live out our God-given purpose. As we do, God promises that He will experience His empowerment and deliverance from difficulties as we walk alongside Him.

Bible Study for Small Groups & Fellowships

LEAN IN: Icebreaker

1. What kind of music do you listen to? How does the music you listen to affect your mood?

LOOK DOWN: Study the Scriptures

- 2. Read Jeremiah 1:4-5. What does it mean that God 'consecrated' Jeremiah? Place the events from the passage in chronological order. What are some insights that we gain by understanding the order in which God operated?
- 3. Read Jeremiah 1:6-8. How did God respond to Jeremiah's doubt? Based on God's response to Jeremiah, what can we learn about his state of mind when he expressed doubt in God?
- 4. Read Jeremiah 1:9-19. Summarize God's plan. What was Jeremiah's responsibility? Who did God prepared to carry out the other responsibilities? Does the Great Commission fit into the plan outlined in our passage? If so, how?

LOOK OUT: Discuss

5. How does our meritocratic world colour our understanding of how God calls us? How can this lead to either pride or paralysis?

LOOK IN: Reflect & Share

- 6. Share a time when God changed your 'no' to a 'yes'. What did He do to convince you to obey Him?
- 7. Share one way in which you are playing your part in building up your local church community

LIVE IT OUT: Respond to God's Word 8. Spend time discussing how you will commit

- 8. Spend time discussing how you will commit to building up the members in your Small Group.
- 9. Discuss the necessary steps towards planting a new Small Group. What roles/responsibilities can each member take to make planting a reality?
