Sermon Guide

Sermon Series: Called by God

The Book of Jeremiah is a collection of prophetic poems and stories by Jeremiah and his scribe, Baruch. Prophetic literature contains many word pictures that vividly illustrate God's love for His creation, as well as humankind's rebellion against our Creator. The poetic nature of the message aims to not only present information, but to evoke emotion in the hearers so that we would be moved to respond with repentance and worship.

In this sermon series, we will prayerfully study several poems and stories from Jeremiah. Our hope is that as we grasp God's love for us and His call on our lives, we will respond to His Word with loving worship and obedience.

Last Week: Called by God

The Bible is clear that we are fearfully and wonderfully crafted for God's marvellous purpose of building His Kingdom for His glory and the salvation of humankind. He calls for us to leave behind our old patterns of self-centeredness and to work as a part of His team so that we can live out our God-given purpose. As we do, God promises that He will experience His empowerment and deliverance from difficulties as we walk alongside Him.

This Week: Bride of God/Mistress of the World

Our passage contains a gut-wrenching image of God standing broken-hearted as His beloved bride, Israel, abandons Him for other loves. Sin is depicted as adultery in order to teach us that all sin is a breach of covenant faithfulness and to evoke an emotional response within us that will lead us to turn back to our loving Lord. The beauty of the Gospel message is that though God is brokenhearted by our sin, He graciously receives us as we are and renews us by His Spirit to once again be His virgin bride.

Bible Study for Small Groups & Fellowships

LEAN IN: Icebreaker

1. Share a time when you signed up for something but did not 'read the fine print'.

LOOK DOWN: Study the Scriptures

- 2. Read Jeremiah 2:1-3. What time period is 'the wilderness' referring to? How does this information impact your understanding of Israel being 'holy to the Lord'?
- 3. Read Jeremiah 2:4-19. What is God's accusation against Israel? How is He going to punish them? Turn to Leviticus 26:14-46 and identify the verses that allude to this punishment. How does your understanding of Leviticus enhance your reading of this passage?
- 4. Read Jeremiah 2:20-37. What images dominate this section? What are they describing? How do they make you feel? Why would the author use such vivid language in his poem?

LOOK OUT: Discuss

5. Read Jeremiah 2:13. What is the message behind the image of a broken cistern? How have you seen our society deteriorate as we have become less 'Christian'?

LOOK IN: Reflect & Share

- 6. How does it make you feel when the Bible says that you are God's beautiful virgin bride? Why might it be difficult for you to think that God loves you in this way?
- 7. Which image about our sinfulness is most impactful to you? Why?

LIVE IT OUT: Respond to God's Word 8. Confess an area of habitual sin to your accountability partners so that they can help you walk away from your sin and towards holiness
