Sermon Guide

Sermon Series: Called by God

The Book of Jeremiah is a collection of prophetic poems and stories by Jeremiah and his scribe, Baruch. Prophetic literature contains many word pictures that vividly illustrate God's love for His creation, as well as humankind's rebellion against our Creator. The poetic nature of the message aims to not only present information, but to evoke emotion in the hearers so that we would be moved to respond with repentance and worship.

In this sermon series, we will prayerfully study several poems and stories from Jeremiah. Our hope is that as we grasp God's love for us and His call on our lives, we will respond to His Word with loving worship and obedience.

Last Week: The Linen Loincloth: Sin Destroys

God created Israel for intimacy with Him and to work alongside Him for His glory and praise. However, since they refused to listen to God, He spoiled them, allowing them to suffer the consequences of their sin. Though sinners are not beyond redemption - Jesus does wash away the penalty of sin and lead us towards holy living - the devastating effects of sin will remain. Therefore, it is imperative that we heed God's warning to flee sin and to pursue Him.

This Week: The Suffering Servant

God called Jeremiah to announce judgment upon the nation of Judah. The people did not repent and instead, abused Jeremiah, causing him to be in great sorrow. In our passage, Jeremiah offers a lament to God, highlighting the reality that God's servants are called to endure suffering. The good news is that God walks with His servants in their suffering. offering protection and future deliverance.

Bible Study for Small Groups & Fellowships

LEAN IN: Icebreaker

1. What is something that you regret guitting? Why do you regret it?

LOOK DOWN: Study the Scriptures

- 2. Read Jeremiah 15:10-21. Map out the general dialogue between God and Jeremiah. Compare God's two responses to Jeremiah. How are they similar/different? Jeremiah responds to God with a lengthier lament in vv15-18. What does this response tell us about Jeremiah's state of mind?
- 3. Read Jeremiah 15:10, 15-18; 19:5-20:2. What experiences caused Jeremiah to lament? Why did he have all of these negative experiences with the people around him? Do you think that this is a normative experience for God's servants?
- 4. Read Jeremiah 15:11-14, 19-21. Organize God's responses to Jeremiah into encouragements & exhortations. Contextualize these encouragements & exhortations for Christians today.

LOOK OUT: Discuss

5. How is God's call similar/different from one's decision to sacrifice & suffering so that one can advance his/her career goals?

LOOK IN: Reflect & Share

- 6. Share an instance of God's faithfulness and how this knowledge has strengthened your faith & hope in Him.
- 7. How is God calling you to honour Him and to build up His Church? What is hindering you from following through? What potential sacrifices will you need to make?

LIVE IT OUT: Respond to God's Word 8. Think of one way your Small Group members can help you carry the load Christ had given you.
