# **Sermon Guide**

### Sermon Series: Called by God

The Book of Jeremiah is a collection of prophetic poems and stories by Jeremiah and his scribe, Baruch. Prophetic literature contains many word pictures that vividly illustrate God's love for His creation, as well as humankind's rebellion against our Creator. The poetic nature of the message aims to not only present information, but to evoke emotion in the hearers so that we would be moved to respond with repentance and worship.

In this sermon series, we will prayerfully study several poems and stories from Jeremiah. Our hope is that as we grasp God's love for us and His call on our lives, we will respond to His Word with loving worship and obedience.

#### **Last Week: The Suffering Servant**

God called Jeremiah to announce judgment upon the nation of Judah. The people did not repent and instead, abused Jeremiah, causing him to be in great sorrow. In our passage, Jeremiah offers a lament to God, highlighting the reality that God's servants are called to endure suffering. The good news is that God walks with His servants in their suffering, offering protection and future deliverance.

#### This Week: Trees Planted by Water

In Jeremiah 17 we see God pronounce judgment upon Judah's sin. While God's desire was for His people to orient their hearts towards Him, Judah remained unrepentant in her idolatry and as a result, experienced the full consequences of her sin. Our passage not only reminds us of the consequences of sin, but points us to God's promise to renew our hearts. By renewing our hearts, He empowers us to live lives rooted in our Lord Jesus Christ, the fountain of living water, so that we can be trees planted by water.

### **Bible Study for Small Groups & Fellowships**

**LEAN IN:** Icebreaker

1. Share a time when you used a temporary 'band-aid' solution to address an issue that required a more thorough remedy.

LOOK DOWN: Study the Scriptures

- 2. Read Jeremiah 17:1-4. Summarize the consequences of Judah's sin. Compare this with Leviticus 26:31-39 and identify the consequences of Judah's sin. Read Leviticus 26:40-43. What are the lasting effects of sin?
- 3. Read Jeremiah 17:6-8 and Psalm 1:1-3. What is the underlying commandment that we get from these passages? What would a 'blessed' person look like today? What does it look like to be 'shrub in the desert'?
- 4. Read about the partridge in Jeremiah 17:11. How does this illustration relate to the rest of the ideas in this passage? How did it apply to Judah? How might this illustrate apply to us?

#### **LOOK OUT: Discuss**

5. What are the differences between one who is renewed and one who merely obeys out of obligation? How does the doctrine of renewal impact our approach to evangelism & ministry?

**LOOK IN: Reflect & Share** 

- 6. How are you intentionally seeking to deepen your roots in Christ and His Gospel?
- 7. Share an experience from your life where you felt rooted in Christ during challenging circumstances?

LIVE IT OUT: Respond to God's Word

8. Ask your Small Group to keep you accountable to forsaking your old sinful heart and embracing the new transformed heart in one area of your life.
