Sermon Guide

Sermon Series: Called by God

The Book of Jeremiah is a collection of prophetic poems and stories by Jeremiah and his scribe, Baruch. Prophetic literature contains many word pictures that vividly illustrate God's love for His creation, as well as humankind's rebellion against our Creator. The poetic nature of the message aims to not only present information, but to evoke emotion in the hearers so that we would be moved to respond with repentance and worship.

In this sermon series, we will prayerfully study several poems and stories from Jeremiah. Our hope is that as we grasp God's love for us and His call on our lives, we will respond to His Word with loving worship and obedience.

Last Week: God's Promise & Pursuit

Jeremiah 29 is a letter from Jeremiah to the Jews who had been exiled to Babylon. The main message of the letter was a call to submit to God's divine judgment. This meant that they were to live a holy life in Babylon while they waited for God to deliver them. The message for Christians today is that we serve a God who faithfully pursues us with a consistent call for us to submit ourselves to Him. When we do, we will be restored to God relationally and missionally.

This Week: (Standalone Sermon)

Living Successfully in Two Worlds

We live in a world filled with dichotomies. One of the perceived dichotomies that Christians struggle with is the divide between the sacred and the secular. Was Jesus setting up this dichotomy in our passage this week? If not, what did He want to teach us? And how does His teaching affect our walk in the path of discipleship?

Bible Study for Small Groups & Fellowships

LEAN IN: Icebreaker

1. What are some of the greatest challenges you currently face in your path of discipleship?

LOOK DOWN: Study the Scriptures

2. Consider the two characters of Martha and Mary. With whom do you resonate more with - Martha the server, or Mary the contemplative?

3. Did both Martha and Mary love Jesus? How did they show their love for Jesus differently in our passage?

4. What was wrong with what Martha was doing, and how was it affecting her life? What are some of the potential dangers of serving in ministry that we learn from observing Martha's life?

5. What is the "one thing that is needed" that Jesus refers to in v.42?

LOOK OUT: Discuss

6. If someone were to say that this story reinforces the dichotomy between the sacred and the secular, or the hierarchy of "contemplation" over "doing", how would you respond?

LOOK IN: Reflect & Share

7. What is currently causing you to lose focus from faithfully living out the balance between diligent service and drawing close to the Lord? Are there things of lesser importance that are distracting you from the life of discipleship?

8. Are you currently making it a priority to sit at Jesus' feet daily? What are practical steps that can help you, or hinder you, in doing this?

LIVE IT OUT: Respond to God's Word

9. Review how you are using your time on a daily and weekly basis and make note of whether there are healthy patterns of spending time with the Lord. Commit to making practical adjustments that will help facilitate this time more faithfully.
