Sermon Guide

Last Week: Thy Will or My Will

The people of Judah approached God for guidance. When they didn't hear what they were expecting, they rebelled, choosing to follow their own will as opposed to following God's will. Their disobedience exposed their heart-stance when they came to God in prayer: they were not seeking for God's guidance or His will, they were seeking God's permission to do their will. God gave us His Word in order to warn us that if we walk according to our will, we will miss out on His blessing.

This Week: Revival and Me

It is interesting to take note that in the first seven chapters of the book of Nehemiah the narrative focuses on Nehemiah, the people, and the reconstruction of the wall. Evidently, their city was rebuilt; however, their hearts were not. What is missing in this restoration process, particularly in the renovation of people's hearts? It is not until chapter 8 that the centrality of the Word of God is mentioned. Can a revival come without the Word of God?

Bible Study for Small Groups & Fellowships

LOOK DOWN: Study the Scriptures

- 1. Why was it important to give the Word of God to the people after the wall's completion? Who should have the opportunity to hear God's Word?
- 2. Note the many times that the word 'understand' appears. Why do you think Nehemiah repeatedly mentioned the fact that the people understood the reading of the Word? Why is understanding the Word important?
- 3. Describe the attitude of the people as they were receiving God's Word. Why did the people weep when they heard the Word of God?

LOOK OUT: Discuss the Following

4. On a Sunday morning, why are there so many different types of responses, both positive and negative, to the same Word that is preached?

LOOK IN: Reflect & Share

- 5. How can we cultivate a strong desire to read and study God's Word?
- 6. Share how we can develop the kind of responsive hearts that will help us to benefit from God's Word.

LIVE IT OUT: Respond to God's Word
7. Make it your goal to read the Word of God with another brother/sister in Christ this week.
