Sermon Guide

This Week: Awaiting the Arrival of the Appointed

In our passage this week, Luke provides us with the account of two individuals that encountered Jesus early on in His life on Earth. Both of these individuals devoted their lives to God and were eagerly awaiting the arrival of the Messiah. And both rejoiced following their encounters with Him. As we look through the lives of these two witnesses to Christ, we are reminded of the value and joy that Jesus alone brings us. And in recognizing that, we are also empowered to proclaim Him boldly to those around us. These are truths that ought to anchor us as we go through this season of advent leading up to Christmas.

Big Idea: Jesus is the one whom we treasure and proclaim

Bible Study for Small Groups & Fellowships

ICEBREAKER: Share about a moment in your life when you *really* wanted a particular gift. What was it, and why did you long for it?

LOOK DOWN: Study the Scriptures 1. Read Luke 2:25-26; Isaiah 40:1-5. According to the prophet Isaiah, what was Simeon waiting for? Compare and contrast Isaiah's expectations for the Messiah with Simeon's in Luke 2:28-32. What do the differences highlight about the emphasis of Luke's Gospel?

2. Read Luke 2:27-32, 38. Describe how Simeon and Anna responded when they saw Jesus. What is Luke trying to teach us by placing these two accounts back-to-back?

3. Read Luke 1:67-68; 2:25-32. Describe how the Holy Spirit influenced and moved Zechariah and Simeon. Read Luke 2:36-38 and note the omission of the Holy Spirit in Anna's story. Why does Luke not explicitly state the Spirit's involvement in Anna's life? How does this impact our reading of Luke's Gospel?

LOOK OUT: Discuss the Following

4. Why is the idea that we need a 'Messiah' (saviour) unattractive to some people? Where in our current culture are we being encouraged to rely on our own efforts to better our lives? How might this mindset affect a Christian's relationship with God?

LOOK IN: Reflect & Share

5. Share how the Holy Spirit has been helping you treasure and proclaim Christ recently in your life. How does our passage empower us to do this better if we are currently not?

LIVE IT OUT: Respond to God's Word 6. What are some things (distractions, idols, etc.) in your life that currently cause you to undervalue Christ or fail to see your need for Him?
