Sermon Notes

When questioned about why His disciples did not fast, Jesus responded by saying that while He was with them, they were to engage in celebratory activities, for His presence was a cause for joy, not sorrow. He also told parables to emphasize that their behaviour was based upon their newfound belief that He is the Saviour of the world who has come to wash away our sin.

Jesus also taught that there will come a day where He will leave his disciples and, at that time, they will fast. However, His disciples will be participating in a new fast where their reason for fasting will be an expression of their longing for and worship of Jesus.

Study Questions for Small Groups & Fellowships

- What are some external markers that, when missing, lead others to question one's devotion to Jesus Christ? Does the presence of these markers guarantee one's devotion to God? Explain.
- When looking at our church experience, where do you see overt celebration of Jesus and of our salvation? Why do you think that celebration is less common in churches nowadays? Brainstorm ways that we can practice the spiritual discipline of celebrating our Lord and our salvation?
- Reflect on the past week and identify specific activities in your life that pointed to Jesus' lordship over your life. Identify two specific changes that you can make to better your witness for Christ this upcoming week
- 4. What are some reasons for us to take up the spiritual discipline of fasting? What guidelines and reminders would we need to remember to help us to have a physically and spiritually healthy fast?
- 5. What are some reasons for someone lacking a hunger for God? How can the discipline of fasting help to soften one's heart towards God?
- Examine your own spiritual condition and reflect on how the discipline of fasting can be helpful for your soul.
