Sermon Guide

Sermon Series: Prayer and Fasting

At NTCBC, we usher in each new year with a series on Prayer and Fasting. This year, we will be going through a mini-series of sermons that will teach on fasting and spiritual revival, and will culminate with a Mission Prayer Service. Our ardent belief is that when God renews our hearts, He not only gives us an unquenchable desire for Him, He also lights a fire in our heart for mission. Our prayer is that as you receive these sermons, God will call you to fast and pray, and through your faithful obedience, He will light a fire in you for Him and for the nations.

Review of Last Week: Hopeful Sorrow Psalm 13

When people asked Jesus why His disciples did not fast, they were question His (and their) devotion to God, as fasting was seen as a positive religious practice. Jesus responded by saying that while He was with His disciples, they were to engage in celebratory activities, for His presence was a cause for joy, not sorrow. He also told parables to emphasize that their behaviour was based upon their newfound belief that He is the Saviour of the world who has come to take away the sins of the world.

Jesus also taught that there will come a day where He will leave his disciples, and at that time, they will fast. However, His disciples will be participating in a new fast, where their reason for fasting will be an expression of their longing for and worship of Jesus.

This week's Sermon: Outpour of Repentance Isaiah 58

In Isaiah 58 we see God rebuke His people for fasting in a way that was displeasing to Him. While God wanted His people to repent from the sinful ways that they were living in, they were unwilling to surrender their lives to Him and offered religious rituals as a substitute. What's worse, in their spiritual ignorance, they expected God to listen to their half-hearted and surface-level fasting. God

responded by giving them a sharp admonition to turn from their empty rituals, and to begin living in righteousness.

While false fasting leads us to further separation from God, as demonstrated by the audience of Isaiah 58, true fasting comes as an outpour of repentance and leads to transformation in the life of the Christian.

Study Questions for Small Groups & Fellowships

Icebreaker Question: What is one way to show love to others that you find very easy to do? And what is one way to show love to others that you find very difficult to do? In your experience, which of these do your friends/family want more for you? Why?

- From Isaiah 58, what are characteristics of 'false fasting' and why does it displease God? What are the differences between an act being worship to God or a ritual that is empty of meaning? How can you tell if a person is engaged in 'false fasting' or 'true fasting'? Identify activities in your life that may be a 'false fast'.
- What aspects of the Christian life are 'easier' for you and which aspects are 'harder'? In the past 3 years, what has been the most difficult thing that God has asked you to surrender to Him? Why was it so challenging to surrender this area of your life to Him?
- 3. How does the Gospel empower you to live a life of repentance from sin and obedience to God? Reflect on your act of surrender: How did God encourage you with the Gospel? What promises did you hold onto in order to be victorious in those areas?
- 4. In your own life (and in the life of your family/friends), what were some visible Biblical promises that came into fruition as a result of surrendering you life to God and repenting of sin?
