Sermon Guide

Sermon Series: Prayer and Fasting

At NTCBC, we usher in each new year with a series on Prayer and Fasting. This year, we will be going through a mini-series of sermons that will teach on fasting and spiritual revival, and will culminate with a Mission Prayer Service. Our ardent belief is that when God renews our hearts, He not only gives us an unquenchable desire for Him, He also lights a fire in our heart for mission. Our prayer is that as you receive these sermons, God will call you to fast and pray, and through your faithful obedience, He will light a fire in you for Him and for the nations.

Review of Last Week: Outpour of Repentance Isaiah 58

In Isaiah 58 we see God rebuke His people for fasting in a way that was displeasing to Him. While God wanted His people to repent from the sinful ways that they were living in, they were unwilling to surrender their lives to Him and offered religious rituals as a substitute. What's worse, in their spiritual ignorance, they expected God to listen to their half-hearted and surface-level fasting. God responded by giving them a sharp admonition to turn from their empty rituals, and to begin living in righteousness.

While false fasting leads us to further separation from God, as demonstrated by the audience of Isaiah 58, true fasting comes as an outpour of repentance and leads to transformation in the life of the Christian.

This week's Sermon: Fuel for Mission Acts 13:1-4

As we a take a look at the early Church in the New Testament, we are reminded of the importance of fasting and prayer in the process of seeking God's will. In Acts 13, God reveals His specific calling for Saul and Barnabas during a time of fasting and prayer in the church at Antioch. As a result, the early church commissions its first missionary journey to Asia Minor in order to bring the Gospel "to the end of the Earth".

As we conclude our month-long sermon series on prayer and fasting, we are reminded through Scripture that God often commissions us as we come to Him to seek His will. As we draw nearer to God through the disciplines of prayer and fasting, we are also encouraged to participate in His mission work on Earth with greater zeal.

Study Questions for Small Groups & Fellowships

Icebreaker Question: What are your favorite study habits or techniques that help you focus while you are working? How do these particular habits help you?

- From Acts 13, we see God reveal a specific calling to the church at Antioch regarding Barnabas and Saul as they were worshiping and engaging in a time of fasting. Has God revealed anything to you during this last month of fasting? Share with your group members.
- 2. Share a time in your life when engaging in a particular spiritual discipline helped you discern God's will more clearly? How did God reveal Himself to you during that time?
- 3. Do you think that God has called everyone to participate in some form of evangelism and/or discipleship work? Why or why not? In what ways are you currently participating in forms of evangelism and/or missions work?
- 4. What specific mission fields or groups of people whether locally or overseas has God called you to engage with? How has He called you to participate in the role of evangelism / missions in these individual mission fields?
