# Sermon Guide

### Series: Galatians – Freedom of the Christian

Freedom is defined as the power to act or speak as one wants without hindrance or restraint. The Bible says that Jesus' death on the cross has won Christians absolute freedom. If this is so, why do so many in the church view Christianity as a straitjacket, where God is restraining them from acting or speaking as they please?

The answer is that although Jesus has defeated the power of sin, many still choose to stay enslaved to sin's power, and thus refuse the transformative power of the Gospel. This sermon series explores God's promise of freedom and how we can vanquish sin's power in our lives and live as free men and women who freely and joyously worship, love, and obey our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

# This week's Sermon: Grace to You Galatians 1:1-10

The Galatians were deceived into rejecting the Gospel as Truth; they had deserted Christ and had turned to a different gospel. Although the level of their devotion did not diminish, and their error was a seemingly small one, Paul said that they had abandoned their loyalty to Christ and were in danger of losing their salvation.

The Galatians are a sober reminder that we must be on constant guard against faulty notions of Jesus Christ and His Good News. We are to humbly receive God's Word and to allow His Spirit to reveal to us the lies that we have believed so that we can repent, cling onto Gospel Truth, revote ourselves to Christ, and experience true Christian freedom.

### Study Questions for Small Groups & Fellowships

Icebreaker Question: Share a time when you received a terrible recommendation for a meal, product, or experience. What was the price that you paid for listening to that recommendation?

- 1. Why was Paul adamant in defending the legitimacy of his calling? There is an intimate connection between one's character and one's ministry. What can leaders do to protect themselves from the type of defamation that occurred to the Apostle Paul?
- 2. Identify at least 3 major Biblical truths from Gal 1:3-5. Brainstorm ways that these truths can be distorted. Which truth did the Galatians err from and how did they err? In the Church today, which truths do you see men and women struggling to grasp and live out? Which truth(s) do you struggle with and how do these struggles manifest in your daily living?
- 3. How did the Galatians 'desert' Christ? Why was this seeming small rejection such a big deal? How do other religions express their belief that 'Jesus is not enough' for their salvation and satisfaction? As you observe your life and the lives of others, how do you express the sentiment, 'Jesus is not enough', in your life?
- 4. What is the cost of rejecting the Gospel and how could the Galatians avoid paying this cost? What are some safeguards that you can establish to help others to recognize errant doctrine and lifestyle and to repent of those beliefs, attitudes, and behaviours? What safeguards do you currently have and how can you increase the efficacy of those safeguards in your life?
- 5. Is repentance genuine if someone merely confesses wrongdoing but does not stop engaging in that behaviour? Brainstorm ludicrous examples of people admitting wrongdoing but not changing their behaviour (and where it is universally unacceptable).
