Sermon Guide

Series: Galatians – Freedom of the Christian

Freedom is defined as the power to act or speak as one wants without hindrance or restraint. The Bible says that Jesus' death on the cross has won Christians absolute freedom. If this is so, why do so many in the church view Christianity as a straitjacket, where God is restraining them from acting or speaking as they please?

The answer is that although Jesus has defeated the power of sin, many still choose to stay enslaved to sin's power, and thus refuse the transformative power of the Gospel. This sermon series explores God's promise of freedom and how we can vanquish sin's power in our lives and live as free men and women who freely and joyously worship, love, and obey our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

Last week: Convenient Christianity

In our passage, we read of an occasion when the Apostle Paul rebuked Peter for practicing a 'convenient Christianity', where he acted out of a 'fear of man'. Although his sin was dealt with properly, the damage was done: people turned away from God and people's obedience to God was poisoned. This episode reminds us that sin damages us and those around us. It also teaches that we must lovingly confront sinners with the Gospel of Jesus Christ so that we can respond with heartfelt repentance.

This week: Only Faith Matters

One of the fundamental beliefs of Christianity is that Christians are justified by faith in Christ. To have faith in Christ means to have a belief that empowers new life lived for God's glory and purposes; faith in Christ leads to life in Christ. This fundamental doctrine has an incredibly practical application: we can all come to God, regardless of what state we are in, and know we are welcomed into His family, not by our merit, but by His gracious invitation.

Study Questions for Small Groups & Fellowships

Icebreaker: Share one 'house rule' that you constantly ignore and need to be continually reminded of?

1. How does Paul argue for justification by faith in Christ? Why is it important that we continue to talk about and uphold this doctrine? What are other core Christian doctrines/beliefs that you feel ought to be discussed more in church today?

2. Why it is impossible for someone to be justified by works of the law? Brainstorm some symptoms of a person with a works-righteousness disposition? Why is it good news that God's acceptance cannot be merited by human effort? How is this good news for those who feel like they're not good enough to go to church or be accepted by God?

3. What does it means to have faith in Christ? What are possible misconceptions of 'faith in Christ'? How can we lovingly lead those who 'think they believe but don't believe' to have genuine faith in Christ? Discuss the differences between living a 'life in Christ' and doing 'works of the law'.

4. How can someone nullify the grace of God and devalue Christ's death and resurrection? Reflect on your own life and identify which of the two attitudes you see more in yourself?

5. Discuss the importance of emphasizing Christian obedience as a response to God's love for us.
