Freedom is defined as the power to act or speak as one wants without hindrance or restraint. The Bible says that Jesus' death on the cross has won Christians absolute freedom. If this is so, why do so many in the church view Christianity as a straitjacket, where God is restraining them from

Series: Galatians – Freedom of the Christian

The answer is that although Jesus has defeated the power of sin, many still choose to stay enslaved to sin's power, and thus refuse the transformative power of the Gospel. This sermon series explores God's promise of freedom and how we can vanquish sin's power in our lives and live as free men and women who freely and joyously worship, love, and obey our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

Last sermon: Only Faith Matters

acting or speaking as they please?

One of the fundamental beliefs of Christianity is that Christians are justified by faith in Christ. To have faith in Christ means to have a belief that empowers new life lived for God's glory and purposes; faith in Christ leads to life in Christ. This fundamental doctrine has an incredibly practical application: we can all come to God, regardless of what state we are in, and know we are welcomed into His family, not by our merit, but by His gracious invitation.

This week: Faith Changes Us

The only thing we need to do in order to be saved from the penalty of our sins is to exercise faith in Christ. The faith we exercise for our salvation is the same faith that empowers us to live for God; Faith in Christ will always produce life in Christ. For our exercise of faith is an invitation for the Holy Spirit to take up residence in our lives, where He will empower us to live for Christ by producing in us a growing love for Christ.

Study Questions for Small Groups & Fellowships

Icebreaker: Share an act of love that you performed that was totally outside of your normal character

- 1. Review the meaning of justification by faith. How does this differ from justification by merit?
- 2. Why will faith in Christ always leads to life in Christ? Compare the difference between the Roman Catholic understanding of baptism with a Biblical understanding of faith. In our culture today, where do you see hints of 'justification by merit', and where do you see hints of 'dead faith'?
- 3. What does it mean for Christ to live in us and for us to live for Him? What does it mean to have a self-centred faith? Brainstorm potential drawbacks to thinking that Jesus' death and resurrection was solely for the purpose of rescuing us from hell?
- 4. Two natural responses to the truth that 'Faith in Christ leads to life in Christ' are rejection & discouragement. Read Gal 2:20; 3:2-3, 19 and prepare a Gospel-centered response to each party.
- 5. What is the connection between faith and empowered Christian living? Review the concept of 'grace-driven effort' and discuss how we can 'stir one another towards good works'.
