Sermon Guide

Series: Galatians - Freedom of the Christian

Freedom is defined as the power to act or speak as one wants without hindrance or restraint. The Bible says that Jesus' death on the cross has won Christians absolute freedom. If this is so, why do so many in the church view Christianity as a straitjacket, where God is restraining them from acting or speaking as they please?

The answer is that although Jesus has defeated the power of sin, many still choose to stay enslaved to sin's power, and thus refuse the transformative power of the Gospel. This sermon series explores God's promise of freedom and how we can vanquish sin's power in our lives and live as free men and women who freely and joyously worship, love, and obey our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

Last sermon: Choose to be Free

The Bible calls Christians to live in obedience to God as an expression of their love for and faith in Him. The Apostle Paul girds this commandment with two encouragements. First, all of God's commands are rooted in His love for us, and therefore, doing His will leads to an increase in our experience of love and life. Second, obedience to His commandment is done out of a heart of love that the Holy Spirit works in you, not out of coercion or slavery.

This week: The Freedom of the Christian

In our passage this week, Paul urges the church in Galatia to exercise the freedom that they have through Christ and to no longer submit to a yoke of slavery. Through several exhortations, he ultimately encourages them to live out their freedom through loving service to one another. As Christians become increasingly more aware of the absolute freedom they have in Christ, they are naturally led to fulfill the two greatest commandments - to love God and love others.

Study Questions for Small Groups & Fellowships

Icebreaker: What is a discipline/habit/action/ practice/etc. that you hate but wish you loved? Why do you wish that you loved this? How would it affect your life if you loved this instead of hating it?

- 1. In verse 2 and verse 4 of this week's passage, Paul warns his readers that they will be severed from Christ and that He will be of no advantage to them if they accept circumcision. Why is the idea of justification by the law incompatible with the gospel? Are there any beliefs or actions that you currently hold to that are also incompatible with the gospel?
- 2. What are some symptoms or warning signs of legalism or licentiousness in our lives? Are there any symptoms of legalism, licentiousness, or both, in your life? Which are you more prone towards? How does the gospel message help you combat these forms of slavery?
- 3. What does Paul mean when he refers to the 'offense of the cross' and who is it offensive towards?
- 4. In verse 14 of this week's passage, why does Paul say that loving your neighbour is a fulfilment of the whole law? Why does Christian freedom express itself in the loving service of our brothers and sisters in Christ? What differentiates being a slave to the law, and fulfilling the heart of the law?
- 5. How does Christian freedom relate 'what we ought to do' with 'what we want to do' in our lives? What is the gospel promise that we receive in scripture (c.f. Ezekiel 36:26, Jeremiah 31:33) regarding these two thoughts?
