Sermon Guide

Last Sermon Series: Galatians

Freedom is defined as the power to act or speak as one wants without hindrance or restraint. The Bible says that Jesus' death on the cross has won Christians absolute freedom. If this is so, why do so many in the church view Christianity as a straitjacket, where God is restraining them from acting or speaking as they please?

The answer is that although Jesus has defeated the power of sin, many still choose to stay enslaved to sin's power, and thus refuse the transformative power of the Gospel. This sermon series explores God's promise of freedom and how we can vanguish sin's power in our lives and live as free men and women who freely and joyously worship, love, and obey our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

This week: Seek the Kingdom

Jesus teaches that life consists of more than satisfying our earthly needs and maximizing our worldly treasures. While those around us may worry about such things, Christians are called to seek God's kingdom as our greatest priority in life and to trust in His provision. Our Heavenly Father promises promise us that when we seek His Kingdom first, we will behold His goodness and be empowered by His love and grace to live lives of worship.

Bible Study for Small Groups & Fellowships

Icebreaker: Share about a time where you felt anxious. How did you overcome your anxiety?

- 1. In the parable of the rich fool (vv.13-21) what was the rich man most concerned about? What did it reveal about his heart? How did Jesus rebuke this man? What are the things you are most anxious about in your life and what do they reveal about your heart?
- 2. What does Jesus tell His disciples to replace their worrving with? What does it mean to seek God's kingdom? How is God asking you to practically seek his kingdom in your life?
- 3. What does Jesus point to as the underlying issue for our anxiety? How does Jesus encourage us to trust God for our needs? In your life, what are some ways that God has demonstrated his provision and trustworthiness?
- 4. Read through Luke 9:23-25, 62. What does God ask for from those who seek his kingdom? What are some of the costs, and what are some of the blessings, that you have experienced in seeking and living for God's kingdom?
- 5. In our passage, what is the ultimate encouragement that Jesus gives us in seeking God's kingdom (v.32)? How have you experienced this encouragement in your own life? How does the good news of the Gospel help shift our focus from worrying to worship?
