Sermon Guide

Sermon Series: Life Under the Son

The Book of Ecclesiastes speaks of the vanity of living a 'life under the sun' where there is no purpose that extends beyond this life. The Bible teaches a completely different reality: God is alive and He has created us for the purpose of living for His glory and His Kingdom

In this sermon series, we will be exploring God's call for our church and what our life looks like as we live under the sovereign rule of God's Son, Jesus Christ. We will be preaching through the different elements of our English Ministry mission statement: to fulfil God's Great Commandment and Commission by nurturing members to be Wordbased, prayer-driven disciple makers and evangelists. We will also be studying the book of Ecclesiastes to identify major obstacles that prevent us from faithfully living out God's purpose for our lives.

Last Sermon: Multiplying Your Love for God

God paints a picture of a thriving faith community as a group of people that worships Him alone, grows spiritually, builds meaningful relationships with one another, and multiplies in number. He then gives us a simple instruction to follow so that we can thrive as a church: love Him and multiply that love in others. As we listen to and obey this command, He will empower our labour and beautify His Church.

This week: Evangelize in Community

God's gift of eternal life is a personal gift to every person who believes in Jesus Christ. Since Christians have received a personal salvation, it stands to reason that each Christian is also personally responsible to live out God's command to glorify Him by sharing the Gospel with others. The good news is that we do not need to act alone; God has saved us into a faith family that also functions as a missional community.

- 3. Read different versions of Romans 3:23-26. How do these different versions aid your understanding of what God accomplished by sending Christ to die on the cross? Summarize the passage in your own words.
- 4. Read Romans 15:15-16 and explain the following terms/phrases: 'grace given me by God to be a minister of Christ Jesus'; 'priestly service'; 'sanctified by the Holy Spirit'.

LOOK OUT: Discuss the following

5. Advertisements spend time convincing people why they need (insert product). Why do you think they focus on the 'why' and substantially less time talking about the 'what' and how'?

LOOK IN: Reflect & Share

- 6. When have you experienced ministry as God's grace to you?
- 7. Who have you been sharing the Gospel with and what are some obstacles you have encountered?
- 8. As a Small Group, how can we work together to evangelize as a community?

LIVE IT OUT: Responding to God's Word 9. Seek to have a spiritual conversation with someone. How can your small group community help to love this person into God's family?
