Sermon Guide

Sermon Series: Life Under the Son

In this sermon series, we will be exploring God's call for our church and what our life looks like as we live under the sovereign rule of God's Son. Jesus Christ. We will be preaching through the different elements of our English Ministry mission statement: to fulfil God's Great Commandment and Commission by nurturing members to be Wordbased, prayer-driven disciple makers and evangelists. We will also be studying the book of Ecclesiastes to identify major obstacles that prevent us from faithfully living out God's purpose for our lives.

Last Sermon: Evangelize in Community

God's gift of eternal life is a personal gift to every person who believes in Jesus Christ. Since Christians have received a personal salvation, it stands to reason that each Christian is also personally responsible to live out God's command to glorify Him by sharing the Gospel with others. The good news is that we do not need to act alone; God has saved us into a faith family that also functions as a missional community.

This week: Nurture with the Word

We are instructed to nurture fellow believers by preaching the Word of God. Every member has a responsibility to preach the Word. While the pastor preaches from the pulpit, all have a responsibility to preach the Word in their personal interactions where we are to reprove, rebuke, and exhort one another. Our passage informs us that in order for nurture to occur, we must lean on the Spirit to patiently preach and teach and to humbly submit to the preaching of our brothers and sisters.

Bible Study for Small Groups & Fellowships

LEAN IN: Icebreaker

1. Share a time when someone refused to accept a gift that you wanted to give them.

LOOK DOWN: Read the Scriptures and Answer 2. Read 2 Timothy 3:16-4:2 and identify the reason(s) why Paul calls Timothy to preach the Word. Define 'teaching', 'training in righteousness', and 'man of God'. How does this information add to your understanding of the passage?

- 3. Read 2 Timothy 4:2, noting that semi-colons are separating each sub-point. How does each subpoint add to your understanding of what it means to 'preach the Word'?
- 4. Read 2 Timothy 4:3-4 and try to identify the 'false teaching' that existed in Timothy's church.

LOOK OUT: Discuss

5. In your experience, what have you found easier to reprove, rebuke, and/or exhort your fellow brothers and sisters? Are there areas that you feel are 'off-limits' when it comes to reproving/rebuking someone?

LOOK IN: Reflect & Share

- 6. How has God refined you recently to be His messenger?
- 7. Share an occasion when you reproved, rebuked, and/or exhorted someone. What were your motivations? What were some obstacles that you experienced?

LIVE IT OUT: Respond to God's Word

8. Share about an area in your life where you are struggle to submit to God. Over the course of the week, pray for God to soften your heart so that you will be willing to submit this area over to Him. Ask your small group members to be praying for you as well.
