Sermon Guide

Sermon Series: Life Under the Son

In this sermon series, we will be exploring God's call for our church and what our life looks like as we live under the sovereign rule of God's Son, Jesus Christ. We will be preaching through the different elements of our English Ministry mission statement: to fulfil God's Great Commandment and Commission by nurturing members to be Wordbased, prayer-driven disciple makers and evangelists. We will also be studying the book of Ecclesiastes to identify major obstacles that prevent us from faithfully living out God's purpose for our lives.

Last Sermon: Nurture with the Word

We are instructed to nurture fellow believers by preaching the Word of God. Every member has a responsibility to preach the Word. While the pastor preaches from the pulpit, all have a responsibility to preach the Word in their personal interactions where we are to reprove, rebuke, and exhort one another. Our passage informs us that in order for nurture to occur, we must lean on the Spirit to patiently preach and teach and to humbly submit to the preaching of our brothers and sisters.

This week: Look Beyond the Sun

Ecclesiastes is a book of reflections from an old man looking back on his youth with regret. His regret was that he had squandered much of his youth, living a life 'under the sun' and largely ignoring His God. The introduction and conclusion of the book serve as a summation of his reflections, with the introduction elaborating on the futility of a life lived 'under the sun', while the conclusion summarizes the advice of the Preacher: fear God and obey Him.

Bible Study for Small Groups & Fellowships

LEAN IN: Icebreaker

1. Share about a regrettable experience and a lesson that you learned from it?

LOOK DOWN: Read the Scriptures and Answer 2. Read Eccl 1:1-11 and identify the reasons why the Preacher says 'all is vanity'. Summarize these 11 verses in your own words.

3. What does it mean to 'fear God'? How does Eccl 12:13-14 enhance your understanding of what it means to live 'under the sun'? Why does the Preacher consider a life under the sun vanity?

4. Read Eccl 12:13-14 and identify all the motivations that one has to obey God. How do these motivations work together to encourage godly living? Which of these motivates you to obey/serve God? Which of these do not really motivate you? Why?

LOOK OUT: Discuss

5. What is something that you consider a waste of time? Why it is a waste of time? How does our society inform us on how to spend our time? Are there any similarities or differences with the teachings in Ecclesiastes?

LOOK IN: Reflect & Share

6. Every person has 168 hours/week. How do you spend your hours? How would you adjust your time-allocation so that your life would better reflect a life that 'fears and obeys God?'

LIVE IT OUT: Respond to God's Word 7. Share about one area in your life that you deem to be a waste of time. Make plans to prayerfully excise this area from your life. Ask your small group members to be praying for you as well.

8. With the time you will create, share how you can grow in your obedience to God.
