# **Sermon Guide**

#### Sermon Series: Life Under the Son

In this sermon series, we will be exploring God's call for our church and what our life looks like as we live under the sovereign rule of God's Son, Jesus Christ. We will be preaching through the different elements of our English Ministry mission statement: to fulfil God's Great Commandment and Commission by nurturing members to be Wordbased, prayer-driven disciple makers and evangelists. We will also be studying the book of Ecclesiastes to identify major obstacles that prevent us from faithfully living out God's purpose for our lives.

#### **Last Sermon: The Pitfalls of Power**

The Bible warns us that the pursuit of power and honour distracts us from God's purposes for us. It also leads us to harm ourselves and those around us for a prize that is fleeting. As God's children, we are to give up our pursuit for personal glory and live with God as our Ultimate Authority. This means that we submit ourselves to being vessels of worship to Him and blessing to others.

## This week: Community is Good, but not God

God has gifted us with the Church so that we may experience deep community with Him and with one another. Many of us are also blessed with family and friends who love us. These relationships are meant to be gifts that we enjoy, not idols we worship. In today's sermon, we are reminded that God alone is worthy of our worship and the one whom we can trust, for He is unchanging and unfailing. As we place our trust in Him, we will be empowered and inspired to love and serve others.

### **Bible Study for Small Groups & Fellowships**

**LEAN IN:** Icebreaker

1. What is a non-religious community that you belong to? What are some of the benefits of being in this community?

**LOOK DOWN:** Read the Scriptures and Answer 2. Read Ecclesiastes 4:7-8, 9-12. What are the benefits of belonging to a community? How do these two passages complement each other to form one point?

- 3. Read Ecclesiastes 4:13-17. Why was the second king better than the first? What was the fate of the second king, and why is that considered 'vanity'? What is the 'big idea' of Eccl 4:7-16?
- 4. Read Ecclesiastes 12:9-14. What is the Preacher's advice and how can we connect his advice with the 'big idea' from Eccl 4:7-16?

#### **LOOK OUT:** Discuss

5. How can our relationships with our family and friends, which are good gifts from God, distract us away from fearing and loving God?

#### **LOOK IN: Reflect & Share**

- 6. Share a time when you wrestled between your desire to please your friends and family with your call to please God.
- 7. How has God used you to be a blessing to your faith community? How have you been blessed by your faith community?

### LIVE IT OUT: Respond to God's Word

8. Share about a relationship that is competing with God for your affections and attention. What will it look like to place God above this person? Pray for spiritual strength to love God more than this person.
